I'm working on the budget at this time.

Time: 10 am till 2 pm (The building will be open at 9:30 for set-up)

Cost: \$5 per dog/handler team/eight minutes of ring time

This will be a ring rental format. You may use your ring time to work on whatever you would like with your dog. Pseudo judges will be available for formal run thrus if desired.

Please be willing to help with setting jumps, figure eight posts, and calling patterns as needed.

Group sits and downs will be held **approximately** half way through the schedule.

Please email me, if you will be attending at <u>sunglow@mt.net</u>. Include your name, dogs name, email address, class level, jump height if indicated, and any special proofing desired.

I will email a tentative Run thru/Ring Rental schedule a few days before Jan 9 so you can plan your arrival time. We will start with the Utility skills and work down through the Beginner Novice skills.

You for sure will have one ring rental/run thru per dog/handler team and sign-ups will not be accepted after 1:00 p.m. If time permits a second run can be had after all other reserved runs are completed.

Please, for **your dog's safety**, keep him/her crated unless getting ready for your run.
